PHOTOGRAPHY

Grade 4 – 6

Grade 7 - 9

Grade 10 – 12

Photos should be the learners' **OWN WORK**, should suit their level of development and only work of a high standard should be submitted. No previously awarded photos will be accepted.

Number of entries:

A maximum of 30 learners of one school may participate.

Each participant may submit only two photos at R25 per entry. In other words, one entry therefore consist of two photos.

Learners should submit one photo from Section A and one from Section B. Please make sure that you add the correct codes to each photo.

Each participant should submit ONE PHOTO REFERRING TO THE SET THEME SECTION (Section A) AND ONE PHOTO OF THEIR OWN CHOICE. The theme/subject of the photo of their own choice MUST DIFFER from the theme/subject of the set section.

The Applications Category of the past has been scrapped and participants should take both the photos at their own leisure and submit both at the same time. Participants will be disqualified if they only submit one photo. Photos should not be older than a year on the date the entries are submitted. Dates may not be removed from the photo's metadata.

The method of submission of the photos will be communicated early in 2019.

GUIDELINES

1. Standard visual guidelines applicable for photography competitions in general will be taken into account during the adjudication process of the photos. (E.g. composition, focus and visual elements)
2. The enhancement of photos by means of adaptation of clarity, saturation, contrast, focus and cropping **is allowed**. However, all changes should be done within limits and performed by the competitor himself/herself.
3. No photos may be scanned.
4. Only photos in their original digital format will be accepted. (No film) Any digital camera or good cellphone camera is acceptable.
The size of the photos must be between 500KB and 2MB (2000KB). The resolution should also be between 240dpi and 300dpi.

(How does one determine the size of the photo? When you open the photo in the software, you will find an option for properties in the menu. The size and resolution will be presented. When you open the photo in Windows, you simply right click and chose properties from the menu. Under "General Tab" you will find the size in KB and under "Details" you will find the resolution in dpi.

5. No photos with the date and time printed on them will be accepted. Imprints that are applied by the camera should be prevented by applying the delete function before the photo is taken.
6. Each photo should be accompanied by a short name or description ,e.g. Sunflowers. Learners of the same school or institution should not submit photos with similar names and descriptions. This is purely for identification purposes and will not influence the learner's points.
7. The organisers retain the right to publish any photo submitted for whatever purpose. The WBE also retains the right to disqualify any photo that is distasteful, vulgar or insensitive (explicit or cruel).

The fact that you submit photos and take part in the Eisteddfod imply that you agree to abovementioned conditions.
